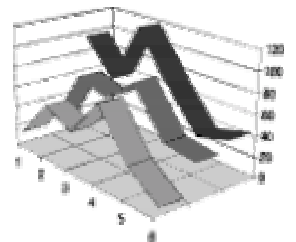
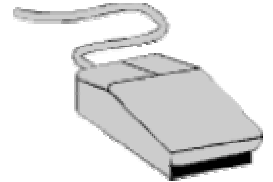
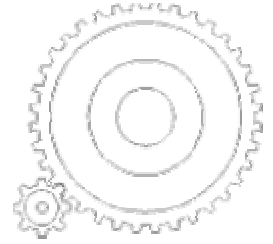


CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Pro-Life Science and Technology Symposium is designed to facilitate communication between professional members of the Pro-Life community and provide a forum for technical presentation and publication. Technical presentations are solicited in areas related to life issues, such as abortion, demographics, cloning, information technology, abstinence education impact, population genetics, stem cell research, genetic engineering, euthanasia, statistics, social sciences, pregnancy counseling impact and use of computer technology. Presenters are encouraged to contribute to the associated *Pro-Life Science and Technology Proceedings* by submitting a written technical paper and/or briefing slides. Paper must be in either Word or PDF format; slides should be in Excel or PDF. The Technology Task Force will confer a “Best Paper” award after the symposium.

College students are encouraged to present well-organized school research projects relating to Life Technology in a special poster session. The total number of poster papers will be limited based on room availability; therefore, it is recommended that students submit titles immediately to reserve space.
